

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR CONTRACTORS

Lake Cumberland Community Action Agency (LCCAA) will be accepting applications for contractor's participation in the Weatherization Assistance Program for the counties of Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, Green, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, Taylor, Wayne.

All interested General contractors, HVAC, and Master Plumbers must complete a Contractor Application and return to LCCAA. An on-line application may be requested and emailed to the LCCAA office. Certificate of Insurance for General Liability and Comprehensive Coverage is required and must **meet minimum coverage** requirements of \$800,000.00. A copy of the insurance policy must be provided along with the Contractors Work References.

Contractors are required to purchase all tools of the trade. LCCAA will assist contractors in completing required training. All contractors must be certified by Kentucky Housing Corporation (KHC) before going on an Approved Contractors List. LCCAA will perform the work write-ups, and cost estimate/bid specification. Bid packets shall contain: Letter of Invitation to bid, work orders and applicable forms, will be mailed out to approved contractors. The deadline for returning bids will be included. Bids may be mailed /or electronically submitted.

Scope of work performed may include: window and door repairs/replacement, attic insulation, floor insulation, minor repairs to roofs, ceilings, other energy measures.

All contractors must attend a Mandatory Contractors Meeting that will be held on September 29, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. (CST), 3:00 p.m. (EST) in the LCCAA Regional Office Conference Room, at 23 Industry Drive, Jamestown, KY 42629.
